Key objectives of the CPSA are:

- to support Cardross Primary School in its work with pupils through developing and engaging in activities which further the education, social development and welfare of its pupils
- to engage in fundraising activities which support the School and advance the education of its pupils
- to consult with all parents about matters which affect the life of the school and contribute to discussions about these. Aspects of which might include:
 - Learning and teaching
 - The school improvement plan
 - Issues related to school budgets and school funding
 - Recruitment to the school's Senior Leadership Team
 - School Inspection
 - Issues related to pupil safety like parking and transport, building improvements
 - School Policies
 - Represent parents' views to the education authority and others on those issues that are of concern to parents, pupils and staff
