Andrea from the Grab Trust explained the harm to animals from the various items we collected and binned.

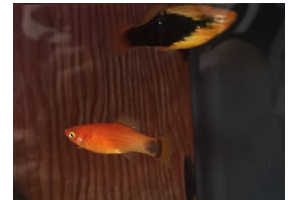
A Sad Farewell
