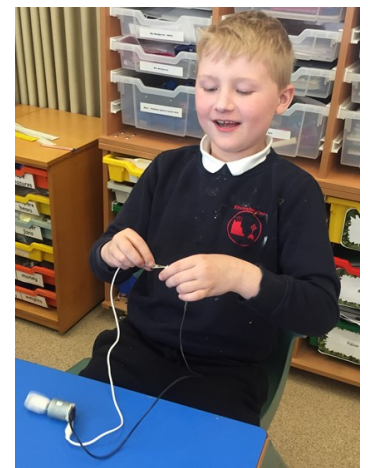
Campbeltown Library
