Signing in?			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do you always ask visitors to sign in? C.I will ask to sign in and will then see if the procedure is in place
Notice Board			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is it tidy? • Staff details • Current Insurance certificate displayed • Current C.I Certificate displayed – this should match the information on the website • Latest C.I Inspection report displayed? • Details of how to complain displayed? • Is information about local groups/services displayed? • Is there a FIS Poster displayed? • Is there an ELC Poster for 2 year olds displayed?

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where is information about CFE/Pre Birth to Three/ DM's displayed? (Is it accessible and understandable for Parents/Carers) • Is there a Handbook available for Parents/Carers to access? • Are the Policies and Procedures accessible to Parents/Carers?
Registered floor space			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is essential, do not change the space you are using without checking if a variation will be required
Is the cloakroom tidy?			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check NHS Infection Control guidance re shoes as each service will be different, i.e. if you have animals nearby • Where are outdoor suits and wellington boots stored? (do not store in the toilet)
Toilets <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Space to Grow: Indoor/Outdoor Settings</i> 			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 flushing toilet to 10 children - can be unisex if for ELC children. OOSC requires separate toilets for privacy and dignity. • Can the children access the toilets directly off the playroom? If not how do staff manage the children leaving the room, i.e. are 2 staff still within the room? (Risk Assessment) • Are the toilet doors closed? • Are they maintained in line with relevant Guidance? E.g. No plugs, pedal bins, lever taps? • Nothing should be stored in Toilets or Nappy Changing areas

Nappy Changing facilities in early Years/ Nurseries and Large Childminding Services (June 2018)</i> • <i>NHS Scotland Infection Prevention and control in Childcare Settings (May 2018)</i> • <i>SEPA Guidance</i> 			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the service is registered for children aged under 3 years is the changing area suitable? • Nappy Changing Unit fit for purpose, i.e. steps, not damaged – plastic and wood.

Management of Medicines in Day care of children and childminding services – check for current guidance or L.A procedures • Handbooks in place: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents/ Carers • Staff
<p>Child Protection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>National Guidance for Child Protection in Scotland (2014)</i> • <i>West of Scotland Interagency Guidance – online</i> 			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the policy relevant/updated? • If using an umbrella organisations template, have the services details been inserted and is it the most current version? • For L.A Units is the updated information included – circulated 2018? • Have staff attended recent CP Training? • Are staff aware of the West of Scotland online course, and have they completed it? • Have you notified C.I when a child is removed from the CP register?

GIRFEC			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are staff familiar with GIRFEC? • Do they know the difference between named Person and Lead professionals? • Are the 5 GIRFEC Questions displayed? (these are available on an A4 Poster style on A&B GIRFEC page) • Are staff aware of the A&B GIRFEC information and how to access it? • Are they aware of the GIRFEC online course and have the manager and other staff completed it? • GIRFEC Leaflets available for Parents/ Carers • Do displays reflect GIRFEC?

(available on SALI) • If Early Level, have they used the Early Level Checklist? • Is a cleaning checklist in place? (available on SALI) • Are Risk Assessments undertaken as required for each area that the children and staff access? • Is provision self-evaluated by staff using QI's within HGIOELC as per setting's annual self-evaluation calendar?
Outdoors			<p>Are relevant Risk Assessments and Policies in place?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do staff and children have suitable clothing and footwear? • Do you have arrangements for drying and storing clothing and footwear?
Office			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are staff files kept securely? • Is SSSC registration in place for all staff?

(Commissioned Providers only) • Family Information Service updated when requested by Early Years • Health and Safety records maintained i.e. Fire extinguishers serviced? • Records for Fire Drills • Have they registered to store information digitally? • For L.A. - are all Property issues logged? • Care Inspectorate – are returns completed on time? • Action plan – are all staff aware of it and contribute to it? • Are there any outstanding requirements or recommendations? Do you require support with these? • Have there been any complaints? – How have you addressed them? • If relevant, how are the Committee/Board operating? I.e. do they meet regularly, are they supportive, are the Care Inspectorate informed when they change etc.?

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are records stored securely? • Vulnerable Children's Files, do they contain all the relevant information and a chronology? • PLP's - are they up to date? • Evidence of Parents/Carers involvement in their child's learning • Is All About Me in place and reviewed termly with parents?
Planning			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are appropriate learning experience and opportunities available for children which reflect CfE design principles?
Developmental Milestones			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has the information been returned to Early Years or inputted onto SEEMIS if a L.A. Unit? (requested by central team)
