

Minecraft: Education Edition Workshop

Let's build!



Minecraft is a game about building, farming, mining, exploring and much more. And all of this can be done not only by you, but by everyone else doing this workshop! By collaborating with each other, you can build something very impressive in a short time!

During this workshop, see if you can build:

- A treehouse
- A farm with plants and animals
- A small village with villagers, “cats” (tamed ocelots) and “dogs” (tamed wolves)
- ...and anything else you want!

From the main menu, click “Play” and then go to the “Friends” tab. You should then be able to connect to the host from there. Try to wait for everyone in your group to join before you get started – if they haven’t joined yet, see if you can help them.

Minecraft is available on numerous platforms, so, if you need them, the keyboard controls for the Education Edition are listed below:

W, A, S and **D** – Movement

Space – Jump/Fly up

Shift – Sneak/Fly down

Ctrl – Sprint (*You can also quickly tap **W** twice to sprint*)

Left Click – Mine (*Also Attack/Destroy*)

Right Click – Build (*Also Place Block/Use Item*)

E – Open inventory

Number Keys (1-9) – Select items from inventory bar (at the bottom of the screen)

Q – Drop item

F5 – Toggle perspective

Z – Mob effects

Esc – Pause

You can find additional controls by pausing the game (**Esc**) and going into the *Settings*, then selecting *Keyboard & Mouse*.
