



### PUPIL VOICE

- Pupils said the event was “inspiring”, “amazing”, “excellent” and “awesome”. One pupil wrote “I would not change a thing” and another described the Arctic workshop as “fascinating”
- Ten respondents wanted to do every activity (groups did 5 of the 7 activities)
- One pupil mentioned wanting to use the LEGO robotics in school
- One respondent wanted more time outside, as pupils had time to explore the beach at the venue
- Other suggestions included mixing more, making new friends and being with the rest of the class (in the group)
