## Activity:

#### Treasure Hunt

The teacher will hide an object outside. With the group she will draw a treasure map of the area with an X to mark the spot. The children will follow the map to find the object.

Each child will be given an object to hide. They will draw a map and the rest of the group finds the treasure.

Can the rest of the group follow your map to find the object?

# Apply (Benchmark)

Draws a simple map, or shares a relevant experience of the route of a straight forward journey, and the method of transport which was used.

Identifies simple features of the local environment, for example, hill, river, road, railway
