The two columns for comments are there to allow for moderation of evidence from two different learners. **Please note, it is not a checklist of the features expected in teachers' written plans.***

Experiences and Outcomes	<p>Do the E&Os link concepts appropriately?</p> <p>Are they taken from a range of organiser?</p>		
Learning Intentions	Do these reflect the expected standards within the Experiences and Outcomes?		
Success Criteria	Are they clear, relevant and measurable definitions of success?		
Learning, Teaching and Assessment	<p>Is there a range of learning experiences?</p> <p>Does the assessment assess progress?</p> <p>Breadth, challenge, application?</p> <p>Is it at the appropriate level ?</p>		

Evidence	Is there a range of appropriate evidence that demonstrates breadth, challenge and application?		
Evaluation	Does the teacher's evaluation of learning reflect the standards?		
Feedback	Is the feedback appropriate to the SC? Would it be helpful to learners?		
Next steps	Are the next steps appropriate? Do they relate directly to success criteria and consider progress, breadth, challenge and application?		
Reporting	Are the reporting comments appropriate? Are they in plain English?
