



Importance of Health & Wellbeing in the Earliest Years Four Recurring Themes




- Earliest Relationships (warm human relationships, spontaneous feeling of friendship and love

Brains are affected by experience!






Bruce Perry's work shows what happens if you don't have positive interaction.


