The Learning so far...

Our topic this term is 'Houses and Homes' incorporating the Bridge of Don community. The children have linked with another P2/3 class from Fishermoss Primary School who are also focusing on 'Houses and Homes' for their topic. At the end of last term the children wrote a letter to a child from the P2/3 class from Fishermoss and have formed pen pals writing to one another. So far the children have learned about their pen pals likes, dislikes, family and interests. More recently the focus of the letter writing has been on learning about the progress of the Fishermoss Class Street and imaginary family. The plan for the end of the term is to arrange for the children to perform to one another in an Assembly sharing the learning journey about their community and have a play based session with their pen pals. Hopefully visiting Fishermoss School and inviting Fishermoss over to Braehead. Lots of fun group work has taken place this term, encouraging daily listening and talking, sharing of resources and making collegiate decisions. Furthermore one of the areas in Literacy is continuation of spelling common words, phonemes and completing reading to write tasks. Our play classroom is based on 'Houses and Homes' and has an exploration table with tools you would find in the home. The children have enjoyed the drama aspect of this play based approach, pretending to paint walls and fix different things. Exploring 3D and 2D shapes and identifying, naming and describing their features are all part of our Numeracy this term. Also the children will be using multiplication to solve problems. In Health and Wellbeing the children are learning about the importance of positive relationships, learning that feelings and reactions can change depending upon what is happening around them. Within Expressive Arts the children will be acting out different emergency scenarios that will occur in their class street. In Art and Design they will be using shapes to create different images. A busy term ahead!

Ideas/strategies to support your child's learning

- Continue to share books and promote reading for enjoyment. Look for Incredible openers and Wow words.
- Ask questions about two digit numbers E.g. What number comes after 18 or before 73?
- Reinforce multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Give quick fire mental questions for number bonds to 20 and numbers beyond to speed up recall of facts.
- Continue to support reading and discuss what has been read to promote understanding.
- Engage with simple homework tasks encouraging correct numeral and letter formation and spelling in all written tasks.
