### The learning so far...

In term 2 we learned about the sixties and technological inventions that have shaped our world today. We also mapped important events in a timeline to understand the timing of inventions in relation to other historical events. We have used the sixties to compare, art, music and persuasive writing to modern times.

We made choices and created mini enterprises – there were 4 to choose from! We worked with our buddy class to help them deliver a Christmas Café. We ran a plate decorating business – called Christmas Crafters. Another group began planning to hold a reading event as part of our school improvement plan to promote reading for enjoyment. Finally another group began to figure out a way to help another class offer a social enterprise and began planning our own class café – to be held in March. More details to follow on that one!

Our Christmas show was also an important event as we experienced the pleasure of performing for our family and carers. We have broken into three groups for class novels and are applying our active literacy strategies with these novels.

In maths we continue to revise what we have learned using weekly round ups. We have worked on division and subtraction. We have also learned about the terms profit, loss and break-even in our enterprise events. We will continue to apply these terms throughout the year.
