On Monday and Tuesday of this week we welcomed 2 Inspectors from Education Scotland back into school to carry out a further inspection to evaluate how we have progressed since the full inspection in November 2013.

During the visit, inspectors spent time with the senior management team, spoke to groups of staff, pupils and parents and visited all classes in the school. They specifically focussed on the four recommendations that were set during the first inspection.
