Reading on myON


1. Visit https://readon.myon.co.uk/



2. Click on Start reading!

Library

3. You'll be taken to the myON **Library** home page. As you can see there are over 7,102 books to choose from.



- 4. You can **Browse** by category, and filter by Fiction or Non-Fiction, but that's still a lot of books to browse through!
- 5. The best way to find books appropriate to your level is to click **Search**.

6. Here's the **Search** page.



7. You can narrow your results to Fiction or Non-Fiction.



8. Then click **ATOS**. Use your STAR ZPD. If your score was 4.6-9.7, click on the 4s to start with. It will be added to the filter results line.



9. Click on Year Level and choose Y7 (S1), Y8 (S2) etc.



10. In Story Type option choose Story Length. If you want, add Story Audio.



11. If you are happy with your selection, press **Search**. Then look at your results:



12. Click on a book to start reading or find more information about it.



13. If you have chosen to add audio to your book choice, you will be able to read along with the audio track. As each word is read, it will be highlighted in the text.

14. Adjust the sound settings.






- 15. Check the meaning of words you don't know with the Dictionary.
- 16. At higher ATOS levels, there are very few fiction titles. Search for Non-fiction.



If you start but don't have time to finish reading a book, make a note of the book's title and the page number, to help you find your place when you return later to continue reading on the website.

2. You can click on one of the news items.



3. You can change text size and the language. Here's the article in French.






