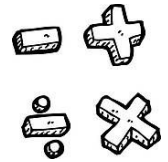


P6 Class Newsletter

Topic

This term, P6 are running their own business in order to raise funds for our school. The children will be creating a product and selling it at the Christmas fair in December. In addition to this, P6 will be learning about social, economic and political current issues and how these affect our community.

Maths
