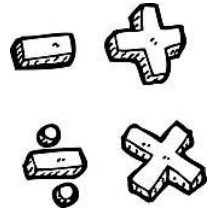


P6 Class Newsletter

Topic

This term, P6 are learning more about the life of Robert Burns and learning a Scots poem and Ceilidh dance to perform for an audience. In February, P6 will begin their work focused on Scotland during the Victorian time. P6 will be learning about the important events which helped shape and advance Scotland during this period of time.

Maths

In Maths, P6 will be focusing on using time and solving word problems. This is an important skill which will be very useful in our daily lives.

Big Maths will have a large focus on division. It would be great if you could continue to help your child practise their mental maths at home.

Language

PE

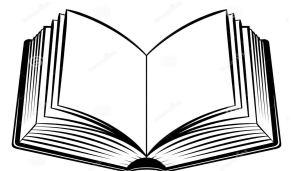
