Topic

This term, Primary 6 are exploring Japan through the novel "Kensuke's Kingdom" by Michael Morpurgo. Our topic will focus on environmental sustainability and we will be researching Japan's efforts to keep their environment clean. Along with this, we will be learning some Japanese phrases and trying our hand at origami paper folding.

Maths

In Maths, P6 will be starting with place value and continuing onto larger multiplication and division.

It would be great if you could continue to help your child practise the multiplication tables at home.

Language

In Language, P6 pupils will be reading Kensuke's Kingdom as a class and completing tasks that help with their understanding of the novel. P6 pupils will have the opportunity to write creative stories and letters using their VCOP skills.

Homework

Just a reminder to please sign each page of your child's homework and reading record. Homework will be given out on Monday and is to be handed in on Thursday. P6 pupils will complete a spelling, reading and maths task each week.

Reading

Reading groups will be heard at least twice a week on Monday and Thursday.
