The Kincorth site is one of several sites across Aberdeen that form part of the wider Aberdeen City Council Housing Programme aiming to address a long-term shortage of affordable social rented housing in the city.

The Kincorth development on behalf of Aberdeen City Council seeks to provide around 213no. residential units of varying size and typology alongside associated shared surface streetscape, parking and both public and private amenity and open spaces.
