The children have made a super start to the term and have so far demonstrated an excellent attitude to their learning! They even won class of the week, in the first week back, for walking smartly through the school!

<u>Topic</u>

Our topic this term is a book study of The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch by David and Ronda Armitage. We will also be reading the other books in The Lighthouse Keeper series, for example The Lighthouse Keeper's Cat and The Lighthouse Keeper's Rescue. Through these stories we will be exploring the theme of the sea. You could support your child with this at home by reading the stories to them and discussing their characters and

main events.

Maths
In Maths the children will be continuing to consolidate and develop their knowledge of addition and subtraction within 20. We will also be looking at Time this term, revising o'clock and learning half past and learning about area. The Big Maths Learn Its for this term are:

1 + 9 = 10, 3 + 7 = 10, 5 + 5 = 10, 2 + 8 = 10 and 4 + 6 = 10. Please practise these at home with your child.

Language

In Language the children will be revising and consolidating their knowledge of the initial sounds and they will be introduced to some new sounds for example: sh and ch. They will be continuing to develop their writing skills focusing on: simple sentence structure, using a capital letter and full stop.

Some other useful information:

- Homework/Reading: Remember to please sign each page of your child's work and reading record. Homework will be given out on Monday and is to be handed in on Thursday.
- Our timetable:
 - PE: Monday and Friday.
- Library: Monday

For messy art activities please could your child bring in an old t-shirt or an apron to keep in school.

If your child has any old comics or magazines they are finished with, it would be greatly appreciated if they could bring them in and we could add them to our story corner.
