

Topic

This term we will be doing two mini topics. The first topic will be learning about the body with the focus on the main organs and their functions. The second topic will be about wildlife and their habitats.




In Maths, we will be:

- practising the two, five and ten times tables and learning the three times table.
- learning to tell the time. Quarter to and quarter past on an analogue and digital clock.
- learning what a right angle is.
- learning about symmetry.
- The Big Maths 'Learn Its' for this term are:

$7 + 9 = 16$ $6 + 8 = 14$ $6 + 9 = 15$ $5 + 9 = 14$ $5 + 8 = 13$ $5 + 7 = 12$
2 x Tables (0 x2 up to 12 x 2) Please practise these with your child at home. The children need to learn these number facts and be able to recall them instantly.

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Language

In Language we will be revising and consolidating knowledge of sounds. We will be continuing to develop writing skills and will be focusing on personal and imaginative writing. We will also be learning about adverbs, plurals and how to use paragraphs. In reading we will be developing fluency and the use of expression.

Some other useful information:

- **Homework/Reading:** Homework will be on Google classroom this term. New spelling words will be online each Monday and should be completed by Thursday.
- **Outdoor Learning:** a change of socks and gym shoes would be useful in case of wet weather.
- **PE:** on a Wednesday and Friday.
