Planning for learning

Children and young people are fully involved in planning their learning within the new curriculum.

Teachers are taking account of what children and young people already know and build on prior learning.

Teachers are also asking pupils what they want to learn so children and young people are having a bigger say in topics they study.



Angus Council have introduced a new electronic planning tool to help teachers plan learning using the national experiences and outcomes at all stages for children and young people aged 3 to 15.

This planning tool is called On Track with Learning and it is currently being rolled out across Angus primary and secondary schools.



What is 'On Track With Learning'?

An electronic planning tool for teachers to use to plan, record assessments and track and monitor the learning for all pupils.

Angus Council has worked in partnership with North Lanarkshire Council to develop this tool.

On Track with Learning (OTWL) allows teachers to plan learning for individual pupils, groups of pupils and classes.

Learning across all curriculum areas and different levels of the new curriculum is included.

The tool will keep track of teacher comments, coverage of the curriculum and pupil achievements.

Teachers will be able to use this information to create a pupil profile which will inform end of year reports for parents.
