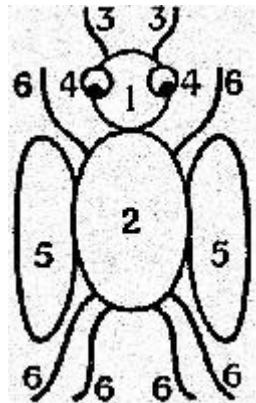

# Beetle drive

The aim of the game is to be the first person to draw a whole "Beetle".

## Rules

The Beetle has 14 parts which are designated to the following numbers of the dice :-



1. The Head
2. The Body
3. A Feeler
4. An Eye
5. A Wing
6. A Leg

Each person at the table throws the dice in turn (the youngest throws first).

The body must be drawn first and the head must be drawn before eyes or feelers can be added to it.

If your role of the dice gives either a body part which has already been completely drawn (e.g. all 6 legs have already been drawn,) or a body part that is attached to the body or head, but the body or head haven't been drawn yet, then nothing is drawn and the next person roles the dice.

Each part must be thrown separately – a "3" for each feeler; a "4" for each eye; a "5" for each wing and a "6" for each leg.

Each part of the body scores 1 point.

When a player draws a whole 'Beetle', they must shout "Beetle"!

At this point everybody stops and adds up their score.

2 people from each table of 4, move onto the next table and a new game is started. At the end the scores from all the games are added up, the winner is the person with the highest overall score (there is also a prize for the lowest overall score at the end.)
