#### LEARNING FOR SUSTAINABILITY TRAINING


Connecting Classrooms is offering a new professional learning course for teachers in Scotland to develop their practice in relation to Learning for Sustainability.

The course will help you to:

- develop your practice to support students' essential Learning for Sustainability needs
- meet the revised General Teaching Council for Scotland (GTCS) Professional Standards, including Standards for Registration, Career-long Professional Learning, and Leadership and Management.
- support your school to embed a whole-school approach to Learning for Sustainability that is robust, demonstrable, evaluated and supported by leadership at all levels.
- work towards GTCS Professional Recognition.

#### PROFESSIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

Take your learning further by developing a professional partnership with an overseas school. The professional partnerships will allow you to seek advice and support on embedding the core skills in your curriculum and classroom. To facilitate face-to-face collaboration on the core skills, schools can apply for a £3,000 grant for a UK based teacher and a school leader to visit their partner.
