BBV/Harm Reduction Awareness Sessions

Our general BBV and harm reduction sessions will provide participants with an awareness of blood borne viruses, reduce the stigma associated with BBV and provide knowledge of prevention, diagnosis, treatment and support for people affected by hepatitis B, C and HIV.

The sessions will also provide information on harm reduction measures including provision of injecting equipment, alternatives to injecting and overdose advice.
