Improving Curriculum

- Clear Pathways** - I can choose subjects and courses that match my personal interests, future goals, and learning level.
- Progressive learning** - I learn in a well-planned curriculum that builds my skills from BGE into Senior Phase.
- Support that fits my needs** - My teachers use information about my learning to plan lessons and give me support that help me to improve.

Improving Learning & Teaching

- Useful Feedback** - I get clear feedback that helps me understand my progress and what I need to do next to improve my work.
- Active Learning** - I take part in lessons where I am expected to get involved, challenged to think deeply, and given regular opportunities to contributing, rather than just listening.
- Having a Voice** - I help shape my learning by sharing my thoughts and giving honest feedback on what works well for me.

Improving Attainment

- Getting involved** - I take part in clubs, activities and achievements in and out of school. My teachers notice and celebrate this.
- Building core skills** - I keep actively improving my literacy and numeracy as I move through school, as well as developing my metaskills to help me when I have a job.

Whole Family Approach Conversation Cafe


