You can choose one task from each of the coloured boxes to complete. Start with the green tasks and work your way up to the purple tasks.

OR you could complete all the tasks from the same colour boxes. OR you could choose any one task to complete – any colour!

Write an **article** debating for or against animal testing.

*Include specific, detailed information and at least one paragraph showing the other side of the debate.*

Design an attention-grabbing **TV advert** advising people on the rights of animals.

*Be creative, use any computer programme, and include detailed information. You could include links to other websites too.*

Create a **PowerPoint presentation** on animal rights.

*Be creative, include all sides of the argument, give examples and possibly add in some you tube clips.*

Create a **leaflet** explaining why animals are used for testing purposes.

*Use key terms and images to make it informative and eye catching.*



Create a **fact file** explaining animal testing for medical research.

*Use correct terminology and use the internet/books to include facts (no copy and paste!)*



Create a **guide** on how animals can be treated humanely when used in the food chain.

*Use lots of pictures and keywords to explain.*



Create a **poster** to summarise different ways animals are used by humans.

*Use any key terms you have found, make it informative and eye catching!*



Create a **picture board** of famous animal rights activist.

*Use pictures and explain what they have done.*



List **5-10** products that use animal testing.

*Write the name of the product, what the product is used for and which animals they use.*



Create a **definition** for animal rights

*Use any key terms you have found, what does it mean?*



Identify some **Key terms** related to the subject of animal rights and create a glossary.

*Find out the definitions of the key words and write a glossary to help you learn spellings and keywords.*



Create a pretend **Facebook post** highlighting what animal rights is.
