<p>1</p>	<p>Low to medium contribution and satisfaction</p>	<p>Parents do not receive information about the different ways they can be involved in the life of the school. They are not informed about school events or the work of the school. The school does not seek the views of parents to support improvement. Parents do not have the information they need to support their child's learning at home.</p>
<p>2</p>	<p>Medium contribution but low satisfaction</p>	<p>Parents receive information about the contributions the Parent Council, Grange Gabbers and Nursery Natters make to the school. They are invited to attend school events but are not informed about the work of the school. The school occasionally seeks the views of parents to help with improvements. Parents support their child to submit homework tasks but are unsure about how to support their learning.</p>
<p>3</p>	<p>Medium to high satisfaction but low contribution</p>	<p>Parents are made aware of some of the ways they can be involved with the school. They would be willing to be more involved but need clearer information about how to go about it. They find out about the work of the school by using the blog and following the school on social media. The school regularly seeks the views of parents to help them evaluate their work. Parents have the information they need from the school to support their child's learning.</p>
<p>4</p>	<p>Medium to high contribution and satisfaction</p>	<p>Parents are fully informed about the variety of ways in which they can be involved and the school is proactive in building positive relationships with all families. Parents attend school events and where possible they help to plan or arrange them. They have an understanding of the school's strengths and plans for improvement. They share their views about the school and trust that they are acted upon. Parents have the information they need to support their child's learning and to discuss their progress.</p>
<p>5</p>	<p>High contribution and high satisfaction</p>	<p>Parents are valued members of the school community who are encouraged to contribute fully to the school's success. They are encouraged to actively share their views and skills to influence and improve school life. The school uses a variety of ways to share their work with parents and to seek feedback. Parents have clear information about the ways in which the school has acted upon their views and opinions. Parents and teachers communicate frequently to support children's learning and to celebrate success. The school supports parents to be able to discuss progress and to extend learning out with school.</p>
