3. Happiness	Overall Mrs Tweed reported that children have settled back into school well and are enjoying being back.	
	Wellbeing webs – being carried out in classes over the past week to give us a baseline of where children are.	
	Daily check in and check ins throughout the day with individuals and classes are carried out.  Transitions prior to the holidays and since returning via Dojo where videos and photos	

	were shared along with our Virtual Meet the Teacher were received well.  Parents commented on how the videos and communication assisted them to manage their anxieties about the return to school and in turn allow them to talk to their children in preparation for returning.  New parents commented on how lovely it is to see what the children are doing at school /nursery and have that communication link.  All parents in attendance commented that their children were happy at school.
