Almost all children who have additional needs and/or who are new to Grange will feel included by May 2024



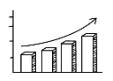
## COLLABORATIVE PRACTICE

- ✓ Evaluate planned opportunities for inclusion in individual education plans (IEPs)
- ✓ Improve the playground and outdoor learning opportunities.

## HIGH QUALITY LEARNING & TEACHING



- ✓ ASN staff will support class teachers to plan for inclusion.
- ✓ FAB Fridays provide weekly opportunities for outdoor learning for all children.
- ✓ Use regular check-ins/ outs
- ✓ Consistently use the ZOR and restorative approaches across the school.
- ✓ We will ensure all classrooms are inclusive learning environments.
- ✓ We will work with children to make playtimes positive.



## EFFECTIVE USE OF DATA

- ✓ All classes use FAB Friday to develop areas identified in class Boxall profile.
- ✓ Involve children in planning outdoor learning activities.
- ✓ Use CIRCLE data to demonstrate progress in inclusion.
- ✓ Use wellbeing data to measure effectiveness of inclusion plans for identified children.

## COLLABORATIVE PRACTICE



- ✓ Professional reading and staff training in writing
- ✓ Review and update writing learning ladders.
- ✓ Training in Daily 5 and support in planning effectively to develop writing.
- ✓ Work in Impact Teams to develop Daily 5
- ✓ Focus on increasing fluency and vocabulary – word work, SRS, work on writing.

## HIGH QUALITY LEARNING & TEACHING



- ✓ Staff work in groups plan collaboratively to use Explicitly Teaching Writing (ETW) to improve writing across all genres.
- ✓ Impact Teams test ways to incorporate elements of ETW into Daily 5: Word Work and Work on Writing.
- ✓ Audit and purchase resources to support improvements in teaching of writing.

## EFFECTIVE USE OF DATA



- ✓ Audit current assessments and look outwards at alternatives.
- ✓ Plan targeted SRS and ELKLAN support (PEF).
- ✓ Use writing assessments to analyse target areas for each class, stage, level, and whole school.
- ✓ Moderation of learning ladders, planning and assessment evidence in writing.
