# How does Seesaw work?



- 1. Teachers create a class. Every pupil has their own journal.
- 2. Pupils & Teachers add artefacts of learning, eg, photos, videos, or drawings. Annotations and explanations of learning are added.
- 3. Approved items are shared securely with parents via the app.
- 4. Over time, a personalised digital portfolio builds up including parent/carer feedback on each pupil's learning.
