Uniform

- Our uniform policy includes easily accessible colours and does not require to have a logo branded item.
- A school clothing grant is available and can be accessed by <u>clicking here</u>.
- Sports clothes are worn on gym days, and any sport outfit is accepted (except football strips).
- We have a stock of underwear and school clothing is kept in school and issued when required.
- Nursery provide outside clothing, waterproofs and have extra wellies for children.
- We provide a welly bank for all outdoor learning.
- You can source school uniform from the Anchorage, which is a free school uniform shop in the town centre. The Inclusion Inspirers group promote the company by raising awareness on dojo newsletters and posters around the school-look out for the posts!
- Langlands works in partnership with Angus Alive who run a 'Kits for All' scheme providing families
 with recycled sports kits to ensure all children who attend afterschool clubs have access to free

Food & Drink



- The Inclusion Inspirers group run a Langlands Food Bank enabling everyone to have access to basic food needs. The group liaise with our local ASDA store who contribute to the food bank each month. Staff supplement the rest of the donations.
- Nursery and P1-5 children are entitled to free school meals.
- Nursery children access free snack during their session.
- Snacks are available daily for any children in need of snack or breakfast.
 This is funded by the money raised by the Rag Bag Collection. The Inclusion Inspirers raise awareness of this charity by advertising on dojo, newsletters and posters throughout the school.
- Parents / carers are encouraged to apply for free school meals if eligible -<u>click here</u>.






Heath & Wellbeing

- Free sanitary products are available to any pupils who require them.
- Free toothbrushes and toothpaste are provided in Nursery.
- Active Schools, staff and parent volunteers provide active clubs free of charge to ensure everyone has opportunities to access after school clubs.
- Free Swimming lessons are available to all P6 pupils and many ASN pupils in both the Hub and main classes.
- A range of dental and medical checks and immunisations are provided in school to save parents / carers travel costs.



School Trips

- All school trip buses are subsidised by Langlands Parent Council.
- Local bus companies are used to keep the cost down.
- Teachers are encouraged to keep the school trips close to Tayside to ensure the cost is minimal.
- Free school trip packed lunches can be provided for all pupils from Nursery P5 and for those in P6 & P7 who are eligible for free school meals.
- We seek grants and subsidies for some transport costs, for example school trips linked to the Scottish National Trust will pay for part of the transport fees.








Fundraising

Langlands Primary liaise with our Parent Council to agree spread of fundraising throughout the year.

- We do not have any themed days that incur cost.
- Most Nursery and School events are free of charge.
- Annual support from Parent Council for Christmas parties, party food and prizes.
