I. Update from Mrs Mallie

- a) Defib training completed in November for all staff and the school was presented with a defib. Now placed outside the gym-hall. It is accessible to the public during open hours.
- b) Inservice days:

- h) Celebration of Scottish culture, with Scottish afternoon planned for next week.
