

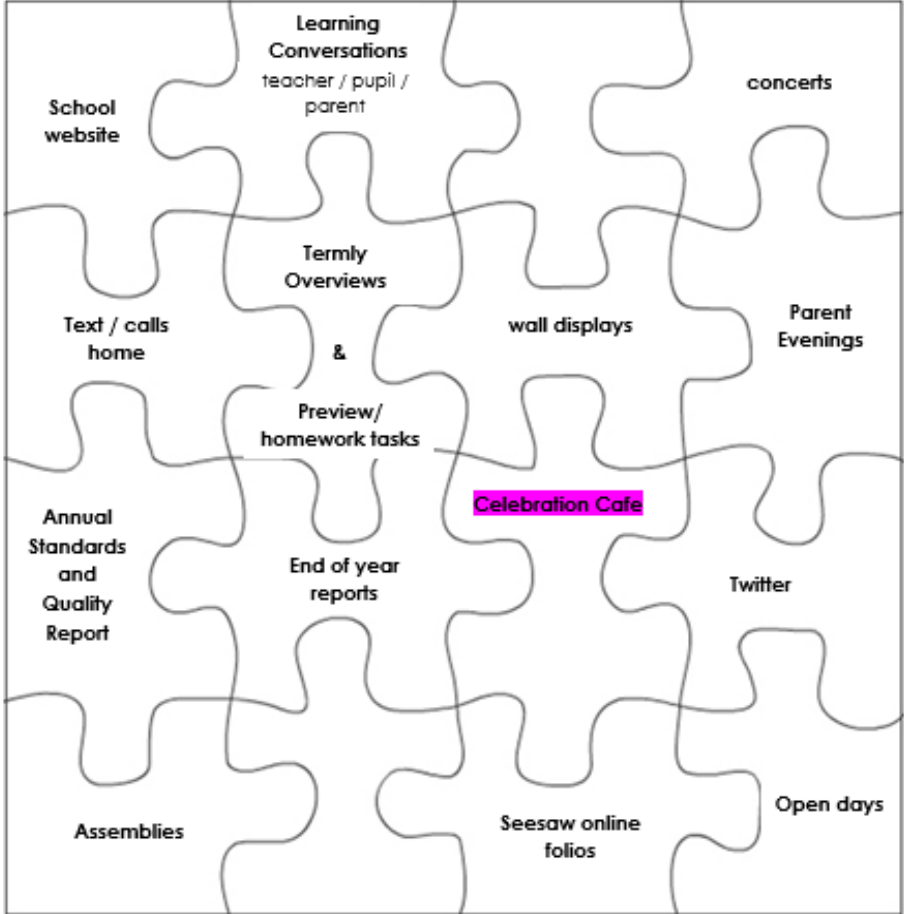

Celebration Café and Star of the Week



As part of our ongoing work in 'making learning visible' at Rosemount we have improved our Celebration Assembly and Star of the Week awards to include a Celebration Café.

Teachers nominate one or two pupils for displaying one of our six learning powers through their work in class or daily interactions within the school.

They receive a certificate and a golden ticket at assembly allowing them to invite one guest to the café which will take place one week later. We understand that not all children will be able to bring an adult from home, however they can invite a friend from school, a brother or sister or even a member of staff so that they can share some learning and their success at the café with their guest.
