

- Deliver staff training on IEPs; create clear calendar for update of IEPs
- Use Do-Jo at all stages to communicate and share learning with parents
- Implement our new planning processes for context/outwith context and updated pathways (RME, L&T)
- Begin to create a Gaelic Languages Pathway (in conjunction with P&K)
- Audit and review transition processes
- Audit and review assessment processes

<u>Using Data</u>

- Identify pre/ post measures at school improvement planning stage to provide clear baseline and evidence of impact
- Introduce and use a new tracking and monitoring system, and ASN database to:
- ♦ Track and monitor children that are not making as expected progress and identify actions/interventions to improve this
- Enable SLT to carry out more rigorous tracking and monitoring of data to identify those facing additional challenges and those not making as expected progress
- After monitoring activities, as well as individual feedback, provide whole school feedback so we collectively understand our strengths and improvements across the school
