Things we have achieved this year...

EVENTS:

- We fundraised £1700 through organising school discos (November and June); a Halloween costume and Christmas clothing bring and buy, and also our annual Family Bingo Night (March).

TREATS:

- We received £400 from 2 local charities towards the cost of buses to the panto, and Parent Council paid the remainder of the bus costs (£70), plus bought ice creams for all the children to enjoy during the interval (£150).
- We paid for the Nursery's Christmas Show run by Tot Stars.

FOOD SHARE:

- We run a Community Food Share from the School Reception Area with produce from Co-Op.

GRANT FUNDING:

- We applied for and were successfully awarded over £2500 in grant funding from local charities, which is being put towards a variety of projects which will benefit the school and pupils.

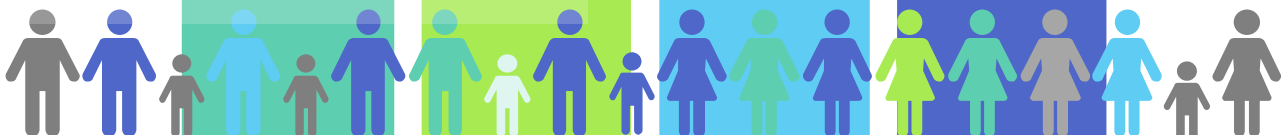
CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT:
