What is a Local Development Plan?

A local development plan sets out the policies that will be used for assessing planning applications. The Plan also allocates land for development, which are known as opportunity sites for homes, commercial and employment land.

Every 5 years Aberdeenshire Council is required to publish a new local development plan for the area, excluding the part of Aberdeenshire within the Cairngorms National Park which has its own local development plan.

The current Plan was approved in 2017 and we are in the process of writing its replacement, which should be adopted towards the end of 2021.

There are 4 key stages in the preparation of a local development plan.

Stages of the Local Development Plan Process



We are currently at the first stage of the process – the Main Issues Report stage.

We have produced a short film on the Aberdeenshire Local Development process. The film outlines the four key stages in preparing a local development plan and can be viewed on Aberdeenshire Council's YouTube channels: https://youtu.be/wTqF81rdGME.

What is a Main Issues Report?

The Main Issues Report is an important document in terms of shaping the future of your community and directing development to the right place.

The purpose of a Main Issues Report is to highlight and explain possible changes to the existing Aberdeenshire Local Development Plan 2017.

The Main Issues Report is the first formal stage where members of the public can get involved and comment on those areas where policy change might be required. It is also the first opportunity to comment on those sites where new development could be permitted. These are known as bid sites.

The consultation period runs from 14 January to 8 April 2019.

Responses to the Main Issues Report will be analysed by Officers following the close of the consultation period. Conclusions will be used to prepare the Proposed Local Development Plan – expected in late 2019.
