



EUROQUIZ 2018 HEATS RUNNING ORDER FOR THE DAY

Welcome by Chairperson, including housekeeping notices (location of toilets, emergency exits etc.)

Introduction of Quizmaster (if not same as Chairperson) and scorers

ROUND 1 – Geography, for teams – 15 questions

SPOKEN QUESTIONS / POWERPOINT, WRITTEN ANSWERS

Quizmaster will read out questions and they will be displayed on Powerpoint;

Pupils will work as a team and write on answer sheet;

Teacher will collect answer sheets;

Quizmaster will display PowerPoint with correct answers and will talk pupils through this, while teachers mark answer sheets;

Maximum of 15 points (no half points allowed);

Teachers take scores to scorers who record them on the scoring sheet.

ROUND 2 – Languages, for teams –10 questions

SPOKEN QUESTIONS (LISTENING COMPREHENSION), WRITTEN ANSWERS, POWERPOINT FOR ANSWERS ONLY

This is a listening comprehension round, including questions and phrases in four languages - German, Italian, Spanish and French. Full instructions will be available for download together with the recordings;

Powerpoint cover slide to be displayed during this round;

Pupils will listen to questions and write on answer sheet;

Teacher will collect answer sheets;

Quizmaster will display questions and correct answers, while teachers mark answer sheets;

Maximum of 10 points (no half points allowed);

Teacher take scores to the scorers who record them on the scoring sheet.

ROUND 3 – Understanding Europe, for teams – 15 questions

SPOKEN QUESTIONS / POWERPOINT, WRITTEN ANSWERS

Quizmaster will read out questions and they will be displayed on Powerpoint;

Pupils will work in teams and write answers on answer sheets;

Quizmaster will display questions and correct answers, while teachers mark answer sheets;

Maximum of 15 points (no half points allowed);

Teachers will take scores to the scorers who record them on the scoring sheet.

Comfort break / snacks

ROUND 4 – Culture, History, Sport and General Knowledge, for teams – 20 questions

SPOKEN QUESTIONS / POWERPOINT, WRITTEN ANSWERS

Quizmaster will read out questions and they will be displayed on Powerpoint;

Pupils will work in teams and write answers on answer sheets;

Quizmaster will display questions and correct answers, while teachers mark answer sheets;

Maximum of 20 points (no half points allowed);

Teachers will take scores to the scorers who record them on the scoring sheet.

SCORING: Total scores will be out of 60. **The 2 highest scoring teams go through to the final round.** In case of a tie, tiebreaker questions will be used. Each team only has one chance to answer a tiebreak question. If a question is answered incorrectly it is NOT passed to the other team.

Round 5 FINAL ROUND – 20 questions for top 2 teams

ORAL QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Top two teams move to the front, taking the card with the name of their school with them.

One pupil in each team is appointed team leader and asked to give answers.

Quizmaster reads out questions, starting with Q1 for Team A (chosen alphabetically), Q2 for Team B, Q3 for Team A etc.

Team confers and team captain gives answer;

Incorrect answers to be handed over to the other team for a possible bonus point.

Scores will be kept by Scorers.

In the event of a draw, tiebreakers will be used (The quizmaster should score out questions as they are used). Each team only has one chance to answer a tiebreak question. If a question is answered incorrectly it is NOT passed to the other team. The first team to get an incorrect answer where the other team answers their question correctly will be out. The quiz will be over and the team which answered correctly will be announced the winner.

Winning team announced by Chairperson, trophy and prizes presented

NB. If substitutes are present, it's a good idea for them to participate from the audience, and mark their papers for interest – they are not, obviously, on the official list and cannot win!
