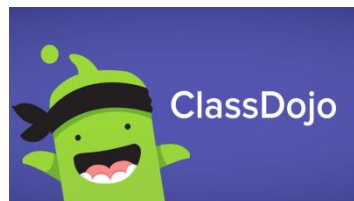


Dear Parent/Carer

- Discussing your child's behaviour or incidents which have occurred during the school day.

Youth Music Initiative – Scots Song Project

This term, pupils in P4D, P4H, P5E and P5M will be taking part in a Scots Song and Language Project, led by Amy Lord, Music Tutor. You will be invited to attend this concert and will receive more information in due course.


