New School Update - Important Information.....

This is going to be a very busy term for us, as we commemorate Abercromby Primary and Nursery and prepare to move to the new school. Everyone at Abercromby is looking forward to moving to the new school, and excited by the opportunities afforded by the fantastic facilities which will support high quality learning and teaching in the modern world.

We are also looking forward to sharing a campus with St Bernadette's Primary and the newly established Tulach Nursery. Some children from Abercromby Primary have had the opportunity to meet and work alongside children from St Bernadette's. Between now and the end of June there will be opportunities for all children from both schools to meet up and get to know each other. This is likely to take the form of working on a joint activity and playtime together. We will be going to St Bernadette's as they are able to accommodate higher numbers in their playground.

Important Information

We have been advised by Clackmannanshire Council Education Service, that The Scottish Government have agreed to 2 additional closure days at the start of the new session in August 2019. This is to allow both schools and nursery to move into the campus. The first day for pupils will be, Thursday 22nd August 2019.

School Uniform

Tulach Nursery

As many of you will be aware, following an extensive consultation, the new nursery in Tullibody South Campus is going to be called **Tulach Nursery**. Tulach is the Scottish word for Tullibody.

A new Nursery Head, Mrs Hazel Blackwood, was recently appointed. She has been in and out of the nursery over the last couple of weeks, getting to know children, staff and parents, and is in the nursery full time this week. Hazel will formally take up the position of **Head of Tulach**

Nursery on Tuesday 7th May 2019, when she will assume full responsibility for the nursery.

We are delighted to welcome Hazel, and look forward to working in partnership in the remaining months we have here, and at the new campus.

Abercomby Lunchtime Project



Primary 3 pupils are currently participating in a Lunchtime Project with Active Clacks, Sports Development. This involves each P3 class going over to the Civic Centre Bowling Green, for two sessions each week at lunchtime. Children are enjoying participating in the variety of different activities supported by the coaches and one of our Learning Assistants.

Sports Development will continue to support us with lunchtime activities until the end of this session and when we move to the new school. This will mean that other children at different stages in the school will have the opportunity to participate in similar activities.



We are delighted that we were shortlisted for the Scottish Education Awards for Employability and Creativity Skills across Learning Award.

We are one of the three finalists in this category, and the only primary school.

We are extremely proud of this achievement.

On Thursday 2nd May judges from Education Scotland will be visiting Abercromby Primary to look at how we have taken forward Developing the Young Workforce, (DYW). This will include interviews with staff and pupils, visiting classrooms, talking to partners and looking at other evidence.

The **overall winner** will be announced at the **Scottish Education Awards Ceremony on Wednesday 5th June, 2019, in Glasgow.**
