Pupil Equity Funding

The Pupil Equity Fund is being provided as part of the £750 million Attainment Scotland Fund which will be invested over the current parliamentary term to 2021.

The Pupil Equity Fund is allocated directly to schools and targeted at closing the poverty related attainment gap.

Clackmannanshire is benefitting from the Pupil Equity Funding with allocated funding for pupils in PI-S3 known to be eligible for free school meals.

This funding is spent at the discretion of the head-teacher working in partnership with the Attainment Challenge Team, schools and Head Teachers.
