## **Breakfast Club**

ParentPay went live at school on 14th January 2019. We will be working towards no longer accepting cash and cheque payments, making the school a cash-free environment. Parents who need to continue making payments by cash or cheque may do so for now, please see below for information.

Making secure payments online using your credit or debit card

#### LEARNING TOGETHER - UNITED IN EFFORT

ParentPay offers you the freedom to make payments whenever and wherever you like, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week - safe in the knowledge that the technology used is of the highest internet security available.

You will have a secure online account, activated using a unique username and password; you will be prompted to change these, and to keep them safe and secure. If you have more than one child at our school, or children at another ParentPay school, you can create one single account login for all your children regardless of which school they attend.

Making a payment is straightforward and ParentPay holds a payment history for you to view at a later date; no card details are stored in any part of the system. Once you have activated your account you can make online payments straight away.

# Making payment by cash or cheque

We will continue to accept cash and cheque payments in school for a period of time. Please make cheques out for the correct amount and make payable to Clackmannanshire Council for all school meals, breakfast and milk. Cash and cheque payments are also recorded in your ParentPay online account, giving you a record of all payments you have made to school regardless of which method you use.

You should have received details of your unique ParentPay Account activation code recently. Please contact the school office if you have not yet received this.

We hope you will support us in achieving our goal to become a cashless school. Your support in using ParentPay will help the school enormously, thank you.
