These guidelines have been agreed with the parent and pupil council following consultation with all stakeholders in 2016.

Why we encourage school uniform in Deerpark Primary School

School uniform has many benefits for your child, you, the school and the wider community. Benefits include:

- giving your child a pride in, and a sense of belonging to their school
- giving your child an equality of appearance which discourages competition
- aids safety and identification of pupils on trips out with school
- heightening the reputation of the school in the community

What does our uniform look like?

Deerpark Primary School uniform consists of

- Navy blue sweatshirt, jumper, cardigan (with or without school logo)
- White polo shirt or shirt (with or without school logo)
- Black, grey or navy trousers, skirt or pinafore
- Appropriate footwear

Uniform items with the school logo can be purchased from the school office throughout the school year.

Primary One pupil uniforms can be purchased at our Induction Days in June or directly from the school office.

Football colours/strips and hoodies with large logos are not permitted at any time, including PE, and children will be asked to remove them.

Outdoor Clothing

The school will provide suitable waterproofs for outdoor learning for every child. These are kept and laundered in school.
