- How you can help.


## Lunchtime

## Lunchtime

- · How you can help.
- Make sure that your child knows what they are doing for lunch. Are they having a school dinner, packed lunch or a home lunch.
- Packed lunches should be brought to school in a packed lunch box.
   These are put on a lunch trolley and taken into the Packed Lunch Hall at the start of the day.
- Please make sure that your child's lunch box is labelled.







### Water in Class

All children are allowed to have a water bottle in class. This can be filled up at our Water Fountain if required.

Water bottles should be filled with water.

No diluting juice. If spilt this is sticky. Water will not stain and will dry clear.

Please label the bottle with your child's name.





## School Bag and Book bags

- Every child should come to school with a school bag.
- It should be big enough to hold an A4 Coloured wallet. This will be used for reading and chill books later on in the session.
- Parent Council gift all New Primary 1s with a book bag. This should be brought to school every day. School communication will be put into their book bag.
- Book bags should be checked every night and letters, crafts etc should be taken out.

- · PLEASE PUT THEIR NAME ON ALL CLOTHES





#### Things your child can do to prepare for school

#### Personal hygiene

It is important to be able to care for ourselves to keep us fit and healthy
Be independent when going to the toilet and washing hands
Brush teeth independently



#### Use a knife and fork

It's tricky, we know! But don't worry we will practise every lunchtime together, practise at home too!



We will be doing lots of sharing and turn taking at school – this can be practised at home too.

#### Recognise own name

Our name will be on our peg and all of our belongings, it will make things much easier if we know what our name looks like

#### Change for P.E

We know buttons can be tricky for little fingers so we recommend a polo shirt for gym days! Let us practice buttons and zips in the house.





#### Things you can do to help your child at school

- Write your child's name on EVERYTHING uniform, shoes, gym kit etc
- P.E Kit P1 keep their P.E kit on their peg and it gets sent home for washing at long weekends and holidays.
- Read to and with us



- Talk to your child about school each day, ask questions, find out what they enjoyed
- All classes at Sunnyside post on Twitter regularly. This is a great way to see what your child has been learning about and you can then ask them about their day.

Talk to us, keep in touch. You are the most important person in your child's life. They are counting on you, and you can count on us to support you both.
