Dear Parent/ Carer,

The First Minister confirmed yesterday that pupils will return to classrooms on a full time basis from Wednesday 12th August. We are excited to be welcoming our pupils back, and are doing everything we can to ensure a happy and safe return to school. In order to further inform the authority's plans and therefore the schools plans, meetings will be held on Wednesday 5th August with pupil and parent representatives.

It is important that I take these opinions on board, therefore I will issue specific details of the return for our learners on Thursday 6th August. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your patience and understanding during this time.

It has been decided that to ensure the sense of community within all schools across the authority, and to further develop children's' pride in their own school, that they should wear school uniform. Please be aware however that our plans are for children to be outside wherever possible.

I understand that this is short notice for many and this is a change from my previous letter. I apologise for this. Children should wear a grey school jumper (black for P7), a white polo shirt and warm, comfortable dark coloured trouser or jogging bottoms. Please do not send your child to school in jeans or hoodies. Dark shoes/ trainers would be okay.

As I mentioned in my last letter, children will not require PE kit, school bag or pencil cases at this time, however they will require to bring a full water bottle every day as the water fountains will be shut off.
