The Coronavirus Pandemic meant we had to close the school for the whole of the final term, the adults have missed seeing you in person.

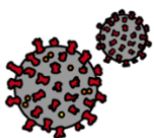
By staying at home you have done an amazing job to make it possible to control the virus.



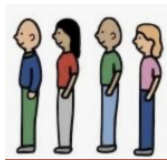
You have told us that you miss being in school and are looking forward to coming back in August.



The adults in school have been working really hard to make plans and get the school ready for you. We want to share that with you now.



Coronavirus has not gone away yet so that means school will be different to start with.



You will return to school on Wednesday August 12th. You can arrive at school as usual from 8:50am onwards.



When you arrive at school your parents are not allowed to wait with you, they can leave you at the school gate unless you are in the Nursery or Primary 1.

Nursery and Primary 1 parents can wait in a bay in the car park which has now been allocated for drop off and pick up.



When you enter the school you will need to sanitise your hands straight away. There will be adults waiting for you to tell you where to go and your teacher will meet you in your classroom.



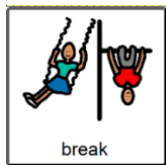
Your classroom is going to look a bit different. You will be directed straight to your desk. Your tray will already be there and all you need will be in your tray. You will not be sharing any resources.



The school will provide all you need, you should not bring anything except your lunch (in a disposable bag) and water bottle. You will not be able to use a peg, your jacket will hang on your chair.



When you are in class you will not be allowed to move around the room as much as usual. Your teacher and adults will still be keeping 2m physical distance during the day.



Breaks and lunchtimes will be staggered so that only a few classes are in the playground at once, they will only be allowed to play in their zone.



Lunch will be a packed lunch for everybody.. Lunch will be eaten in your classroom at your desk, when everyone is finished you will be taken outside to play.



At the end of the day all of your resources will be left in your tray. Your teacher will line you up and take you out. You will be taken into the playground and the teacher will supervise your dismissal.
