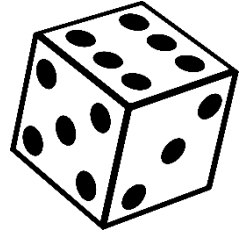


Roll a Dice Word Challenge



Grab the book you are reading at the moment or another story or text in your house. This could be your school library book, a book you have at home or an eBook I have shared.

Read the book and when you come across a new and unfamiliar word, roll a dice 3 times and complete the 3 matching activities (if you do not have a dice, you could make one or choose any 3 numbers).

The activities will help you understand the word and be able to use it for yourself.

1 - Write a synonym for your word (remember a synonym is a word that has the same meaning e.g. big and huge)

2 - Write an antonym for your word (remember an antonym is a word that has the opposite meaning e.g. big and small)

3 - Illustrate your word

4 - Use the word in a sentence of your own

5 - Act out your word to a family member

6 - Create an alliteration containing your word (remember alliteration means the words have the same letter or sound at the beginning e.g. Larry's Leaping Lizard). Challenge- how many words can you include? Can you create a silly sentence using alliteration and the new word?
