Cereal Box Guitar

You will need:

- Cereal box
- Elastic bands 4-6
- Kitchen roll or wrapping paper tube
- Scissors
- Sticky tape



What To Do:





Before you start, tape up the open end of your cereal box.



Draw and cut out a large hole in the centre of your guitar.



Using your tube, draw a circle on one end of your box and cut it out.





Place your tube into the box through the smaller hole at the end. Secure it in place with some sticky tape.



Place elastic bands over each end of your guitar, ensuring they sit over the large hole in the middle.



Slide a pencil under the elastic bands at each end of the box, to lift them slightly.





Try elastic bands of different thicknesses and see if they make higher or lower sounds.
