



Primary 1 – Term 1 Learning



Literacy

In class this term, our literacy learning will focus on:

- Learning the Set 1 sounds through the Read, Write, Inc approach.
- Building our skills as active listeners through stories, group activities, games and whole class carpet time activities.
- Learning to blend sounds to make words.
- Learning the correct formation of each letter / letters which represent a sound.
- Using the colourful semantics approach to explore fairytales and nursery rhymes, using “who” “what” “where” and “what doing”.
- Recognising and writing our first name, applying our knowledge of sounds and letters.

Numeracy and Mathematics

In class this term, our numeracy and mathematics learning will focus on:

- Building a conceptual understanding of number, beginning with numbers 0 – 10.
- Ordering and sequencing.
- Counting skills, including 1:1 correspondence and estimation.
- Sorting and matching.

Interdisciplinary Learning

In class this term, through interdisciplinary learning we will:

- Learn about “people who help us” through a range of media and visits.
- Learn about our school and local community.
- Learn how to log on to the technology in school and navigate to explore games and programmes which support our learning.
- Learn basic greetings in French.

Health and Wellbeing

In class this term, our health and wellbeing learning will focus on:

- Foundation skills in PE, including throwing, catching, bouncing, balancing, coordination, spatial awareness, movement skills and travelling in different ways.
- Learning how to be part of simple group and team activities in PE, including turn taking and listening carefully to instructions.
- Looking after myself (personal hygiene and routines).
- Healthy eating.

Religious Education (RERC)

In class this term, our religious education learning will focus on:

- The theme of belonging in God’s world.
- Learning the sign of the cross and basic prayers.
- Learning that when we pray we are speaking to God. Understanding why we pray.
- Experiencing church and Mass with our class and school community/family.
