Make



The fiddle is a musical instrument. Make your own musical instrument. A box with elastic bands makes a great sound. Tupperware boxes with dry beans can make a drum. Empty plastic bottles filled with lentils could be used as shakers. What other ideas do you have?


<u>Rhyme</u>



Learn the rhyme (see rhyme sheet).

Practise saying the rhyme aloud. Make actions to go along with the rhyme.

Talk time



Create puppets for each of the characters from the rhyme (the cat, the cow, the dog, the dish and the spoon). You can use these attached to lolly sticks for puppets. Act out the rhyme using your puppets.

Help



Two of the characters from the rhyme are the dish and the spoon. Help your family to set out what you need for a meal. How many dishes will you need? How many spoons (and forks / knives) will you need? Count and lay them out ready for the meal.

Join in







Watch the <u>video</u> and join in singing the Hey Diddle Diddle rhyme.

Listen to a <u>new version of the rhyme</u>, made as a story, being read.
