## Baa Baa Black Sheep

### Make



Draw or create a picture of a sheep. You can use cotton wool or other materials to make your sheep textured.

You may also wish to choose a different colour for your sheep.

### <u>Rhyme</u>



Learn the rhyme (see rhyme sheet).



Practise saying the rhyme aloud. Make actions to go along with the rhyme.



Sheep starts with the /sh/ shound. Try making the /sh/ sound. How many words can you think of and say which start with the /sh/ sound?

Examples - shoe, shop, short, shoulder etc.

### Count





People sometimes close their eyes and count sheep when they find are finding it hard to sleep. Try pretending that you are counting sheep. How high can you count?

### Join in







Watch the video and join in singing the Baa Baa Black Sheep rhyme.

Listen to a <u>Baa Baa Black Sheep story book</u> being read.
