# 1,2,3,4,5. Once I Caught A Fish Alive


#### Create



Enjoy one or more of these fish-inspired art activities:

- Make a <u>moving paper fish</u>.
- Create a 3D fish craft.
- Make a paper fan fish.
- Develop your motor skills making this fish using weaving.

## <u>Rhyme</u>





Learn the rhyme (see rhyme sheet).

Practise saying the rhyme aloud. Make actions to go along with the rhyme.

#### Talk time



Fish are just one type of creature which live in the sea. Talk with an adult at home. Name as many sea creatures as you can. Which is your favourite sea creature and why? Watch <u>Blue Planet</u> and talk about all the wonderful creatures you see.

# Counting



Make 10 fish from paper. Count out the fish as you say / sing the rhyme.

Practise taking fish away and adding fish to the group. Count the total number of fish you can see altogether. Can you write the total as a number?

## <u>Join in</u>







Watch the video and join in singing the rhyme.

Join in with <u>Mr Tumble</u> and learn the Makaton to accompany the rhyme.

Learn <u>these actions</u> to the rhyme and try to add these in as you say / sing it.
